



WKO - World Grand Prix

The WKO World Grand Prix are formed from results of competitors who have entered WKO Open Championships.

WKO World Grand Prix Ranking Events from the annual season from:

- WKO English Open
- WKO Arnold Championships
- WKO British Open
- WKO K-1 National Championships
- WKO 5 Nations Open
- WKO European Open
- WKO K-1 World Championships
- WKO Open World Championships

WKO World Grand Prix Ranking Points Are:

- Gold Medallist 4 Points
- Silver Medallist 3 Points
- Bronze Medallist 2 Point
- None Medallists 1 Point

(1 point is awarded to those do not achieve a medal placing, so this can still acquire points throughout the season)

As the season progresses the fighter with the most points of the weight division will be listed as Number 1 for their Age/Weight.

Then once the season has finished all the fighters who are No1 of their Actual Age/Weight/Gender and Rules will be listed and publicised on the Grand Prix Rankings & Leaderboard.

If you are top of your Age/Weight/Gender/Rules within that rule set, then you are eligible to order the **WKO World Grand Prix, Grand Champion Belt** if desire to do so.
(these are of course optional purchases)

Throughout the season all points are added up, most amount of points at the end of the season then:

Number One Rank of the Grand Prix and WKO Grand Prix, Grand Champion of their respective group culminating of:

- Rules
- Gender
- Age
- Weight

Grand Prix Weight Groups:

- Quantumweight Minus 20kg
- Subatomicweight Minus 25k
- Electronweight Minus 30k
- Protonweight Minus 35kg
- Neutronweight Minus 40kg
- Atomweight Minus 45kg
- Flyweight Minus 50kg
- Super Bantamweight Minus 55kg
- Super Featherweight Minus 60kg
- Super Lightweight Minus 65kg
- Super Welterweight Minus 70kg
- Super Middleweight Minus 75kg
- Light Heavyweight Minus 80kg
- Cruiserweight Minus 85kg
- Super Cruiserweight Minus 90kg
- Heavyweight Minus 95kg
- Super Heavyweight Over 95kg

The above weight classes/groups are then split into the relevant and fair age groups which the majority of athletes will have contested within.

Grand Prix Age Groups:

- Peewee 5-7yrs
- Super Peewee 8-9yrs
- Junior 10-11yrs
- Super Junior 12-13yrs
- Cadets 14-15yrs
- Super Cadets 16-17yrs
- Seniors 18yrs+
- Veterans 35yrs+
- Masters 45yrs+

WKO Grand Prix is compiled from each **WKO Open Championships** both National and International events. With thousands of competitors from around the world, who are competing in both Ring & Tatami Sports.

This makes all WKO Open Championships, AAA events Achievement, Acknowledgement and be Awarded.

These World Grand Prix results will be updated following every WKO Open Championships, then at the end of the year the Number one is the World Grand Prix – Grand Champion for that year.

Congratulations to all ranked fighters this is an achievement within itself and a testament to yourself, your club and your coach.
